

**Notice**  
**The Surrey County Council**  
**Ferry Lane (D6285) and Towpath (D6284), Shepperton**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 10 November 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in

- (a) that length of Ferry Lane (D6285) Shepperton as extends from its junction with Towpath (D6284) Shepperton north westwards for a distance of 40 metres; and
- (b) that length of Towpath (D6284) Shepperton as extends from its junction with Ferry Lane (D6285) Shepperton south westwards for a distance of approximately 40 metres.

Alternative Route – Ferry Lane; Chertsey Lane; Dockett Eddy Lane; and Towpath.

The Order is required to facilitate water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Affinity Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9am and 4pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 15 November 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times via assistance from a Traffic Marshall, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
