Rydens Way (D3719) Old Woking
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 01 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Rydens Way (D3719) Old Woking as extends from its northern junction with (D3718) Sundridge Road eastwards for a distance of approximately 50 metres.

Alternative Route – Sundridge Road; and the southern arm of Rydens Way or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate construction works to be carried out by, or on behalf of William Lacey Group Ltd within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 10 months between the hours of 7.30am and 5.30pm Monday to Friday and 7.30am and 12pm on Saturdays within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 06 December 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Residents, pedestrians, cyclists, and all other traffic will be required to use the diversion route due to the nature of the works and for reasons of safety. No sole access will be affected by this closure.
