London Road (A308) Staines Upon Thames
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 02 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from entering or proceeding on foot or by any other means in that length of the footway adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of London Road (A308) Staines Upon Thames as extends from its junction with (C248) Kingston Road to its north-eastern junction with (D3282) Fairfield Avenue.

The alternative route will be via the opposite footway adjacent to the westbound carriageway.

The Order is required to facilitate mains water connection and/or repair and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Keltic Traffic Management within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 10 days within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 11 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be via the opposite footway.
