

**Notice**  
**The Surrey County Council**  
**Hazelwood Lane (C137) Chipstead**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 09 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Hazelwood Lane (C137) Chipstead as extends from its junction with (B2032) Outwood Lane to its junction with (X97123) Hazel Way.

Alternative Route - Outwood Lane; Waterhouse Lane; Bonsor Drive; A217 Brighton Road; Blackhorse Lane; High Road; and Hazelwood Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 9am and 5pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 14 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained as far as possible.
