

**The Surrey County Council  
Studios Road (D6299) Shepperton  
Temporary Prohibition of Waiting Order 2022**

On 9 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles, at any time, in that length of Studios Road (D6299) Shepperton, as extends from its junction with Squires Bridge Road to a point 20m north-east of its junction with Astleham Road (in addition to the existing permanent no waiting at any time restriction that applies to part of the southern side of the said length of road).

The Temporary Traffic Order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public, caused by obstructive parking, and will commence on 12 February 2022 and continue for a period of 18 months. The temporary waiting restrictions will only apply when the relevant traffic signs are in place. Exemptions are provided in respect of the temporary waiting restrictions to permit vehicles to wait in order to pick up and set down passengers, or to load and unload goods and for disabled persons vehicles in accordance with the Blue Badge Scheme; where necessary to carry out essential services and works or when used by local authorities in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for furniture removals and Post Office vehicles; vehicles when waiting because the driver is required by law to stop, are obliged to stop in order to prevent an accident or are prevented from proceeding because of circumstances outside the driver's control; and in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer.
