

**Notice**  
**The Surrey County Council**  
**Prune Hill (D3191) Englefield Green**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 23 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Prune Hill (D1391) Englefield Green as extends from its junction with Public Footpath No.40 Egham to its junction with the access to the property known as "Rusham Park"; and
- (b) Suspend "The Surrey County Council Prune Hill (D1391) Englefield Green Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.2) 2021" insofar as it affect the length of road described in part (a) to this Notice.

Alternative Route – Prune Hill; Bakeham Lane; A30 Egham Hill; High Street; Church Road; High Street; Vicarage Road; New Wickham Lane; Stroude Road; Whitehall Lane; and Prune Hill or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate new telecoms pole installation works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 days between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 05 March 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
