Fifield Lane (D113) Frensham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 23 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of Fifield Lane (D113) Frensham.

The alternative route will be via Kennel Lane; and A287 Frensham Road or this same route in reverse; and

- (b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council Fifield Lane (D113) Frensham Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021” in its entirety.

The Order is required to allow new mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of South East Water at two locations within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 weeks between the hours of 7.30am and 5pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 28 March 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
