Plaistow Road (C33) Dunsfold
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 06 April 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Plaistow Road (C33) Dunsfold from its junction with the access to "Burnthill Mobile Home Park" to its junction with the access to the property known as "Burningfold Manor".

Alternative Route – Plaistow Road; Fisher Lane; Pickhurst Road; High Street Green; Chiddingfold Road; and Plaistow Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow mains water replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Morrison Utility Services and/or Thames Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 4 weeks between the hours of 7am and 7pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 11 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents, the emergency services and cyclists will be maintained at all times.
