Church Lane (D1421) Chaldon
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 11 May 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to

(a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Church Lane (D1421) Chaldon as extends from its junction with (B2031) Rook Lane to a point in line with the common boundary between the properties known as "Hillcroft" and "The Warren";

(b) suspend "The Surrey County Council D1421 Church Lane, Chaldon Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021" in its entirety; and

(c) suspend "The Surrey County Council D1421 Church Lane, Chaldon Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order No.3 2021" in its entirety.

Alternative Route – Church Lane; Doctors Lane; and Rook Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate new telecoms pole installation works and/or new customer connection and/or cabling and/or utility maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 17 May 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure and suspensions will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained via operatives on site as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
