High Court Claim for Injunction against "Persons Unknown"

On 5 September 2022 Surrey County Council issued proceedings in the High Court seeking an interim and final injunction for protection of Chobham Common, (identified at www.surreycc.gov.uk/community/housing/gypsies-and-travellers/high-court-interim-injunction-chobham-common) forbidding 'Persons Unknown' from:

- 1. setting up an encampment within the boundaries of Chobham Common without the express written permission of the Claimant as Landowner;
- 2. entering or occupying for residential purposes within the boundaries of Chobham Common without the express written permission of the Claimant as Landowner:
- 3. depositing waste or fly-tipping within the boundaries of Chobham Common without the express written permission of the Claimant as Landowner.

On 21 October 2022 the High Court granted the Council's application for alternative service of the claim.
