Sandy Lane (D6851) Cobham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.2) 2022

On 09 November 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to –

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Sandy Lane (D6851) Cobham as extends from its junction with (A244) Copsem Lane/Warren Lane to its junction with (D6852) The Ridings.
Alternative Routes – (1) Sandy Lane; Miles Lane; Fairmile Lane; A307 Portsmouth Road/High Street; and A244 Claremont Lane/Copsem Lane, and (2) A244 Warren Lane/Leatherhead Road/Oxshott Road; Oaklawn Road; A245 Woodlands Road/Woodlands Lane/Stoke Road; Fairmile Lane; Miles Lane; and Sandy Lane; and
- (b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council Sandy Lane (D6851) Cobham Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022” in its entirety.

The Order is required to allow underground telecoms utility works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 22 November 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by operatives on site as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
