Stoatley Hollow (D5513) Haslemere
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 30 November 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Stoatley Hollow (D5513) Haslemere from its junction with (D134) Farnham Lane to its junction with (D5514) Bunch Lane.

Alternative Route – Bunch Lane; and Farnham Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of I&G Contractors Ltd and/or SGN within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 9 days between the hours of 7am and 7pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 12 December 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained where safe to do so, if necessary, via the diversion route. All other vehicular traffic will be required to use the signed diversion route.

The Council are satisfied that, in accordance with Section 3(2)(a) and 3(2)(b) of the Act, vehicular access to and from premises within the length of road above, or accessible only therefrom, may be restricted in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and/or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
