D194 Brook Hill, Albury
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 30 November 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of D194 Brook Hill, Albury that extends from its junction with D222 Brook Lane, to its junction with D214 August Lane.

This Traffic Order is required to enable UK Power Networks to carry out electrical connection and/or maintenance works in that length of D194 Brook Hill, Albury that extends alongside its boundary with "Southside Cottage". These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 5pm, within 5 days of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 12 December 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure which is anticipated to be required for 24 hours each day will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for emergency services, residents, businesses, pedestrians, cyclists, and equestrians will be maintained at all times. The vehicular diversion route will be via Brook Hill, Brook Lane, Little London, Hound House Road, Barhatch Road, Greensand Lane, Shophouse Lane, Row Lane, Shophouse Lane, August Lane and Brook Hill.
