A3100 London Road, Burpham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 05 October 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to: -

- a) Prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of A3100 London Road, Burpham that extends from the southern side of its junction with B2234 New Inn Lane, to the eastern side of its junction with D4012 Boxgrove Road and/or any part and/or parts therein.
- b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council (Clay Lane, Jacobs Well) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order 1986” that imposes the existing weight restriction in Clay Lane, in its entirety.

This Traffic Order is required to enable Surrey County Council to carry out lining and footway/carriageway resurfacing works for the construction of new segregated cycle ways on both sides of the carriageway, installation of toucan crossings and parallel crossing and/or maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be carried out in sections throughout the 18 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 24 October 2022.

Note - The phases of works are anticipated to be carried out: -

1. between the hours of 8pm and 6am, in phases of approximately 5 nights
 - a) In the full width of A3100 London Road, Burpham that extends from the north-eastern side of its roundabout junction with Boxgrove Road, to the south-western side of its roundabout junction with Woodruff Avenue.
 - b) In the spurs to the roundabout junction of A3100 London Road, Burpham with D4012 Woodruff Avenue and D4012 Weylea Avenue.
2. 24 hour closure to all northbound traffic on A3100 London Road, Burpham for the duration of the scheme, in two sections –

- a) from the north-eastern side of its roundabout junction with Boxgrove Road, to the south-western side of its roundabout junction with Woodruff Avenue (approx. 192 days with the anticipated dates 07/11/2022 – 17/06/23).
- b) from the north-eastern side of its roundabout junction with Woodruff Avenue, to the southern side of its roundabout junction with B2234, New Inn Lane (approx. 122 days with anticipated dates 19/06/23 – 07/11/2023). In each section the works are anticipated to commence on the west side of the carriageway/footway and once complete move to the east side. Southbound traffic will be required to drive contra-flow while works are carried out on the east sides.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure and suspension will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for pedestrians and, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times under direction via the opposite footway. Access for emergency services, residents, businesses, cyclists, and equestrians will be maintained via the vehicular diversion route: - Southbound – A3100 London Road, A3100 Clay Lane, C14 Clay Lane, A320 Woking Road and A25 Parkway. Northbound – A25 Parkway, A320 Woking Road, C14 Clay Lane, A3100 Clay Lane, and A3100 London Road. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to a suitable location outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.
