D235 Tannery Lane and D236 Papercourt Lane, Send
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 01 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to: - Prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of D235 Tannery Lane and D236 Papercourt Lane, Send that extends from the junction with Clockbarn Way, to the junction with B367 Newark Lane. 2. Suspend "The Surrey County Council Tannery Lane (D235) Send Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022" in its entirety. This Traffic Order is required to enable Power On to carry out electrical infrastructure works in D235 Tannery Lane, Send between the junction with Clockbarn Way and the south-eastern property boundary of "The Tannery". These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 6pm, within 1 day of the 10 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 07 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for emergency vehicles, residents, businesses, HGVs, pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times under direction of site operatives. Alternative route: - Tannery Lane, Send Road, Send Marsh Road, Send Marsh Green, Polesden Lane, Newark Lane and Papercourt Lane.
