

ALLOCATION OF JUNIOR SCHOOL PLACES IN SURREY FOR SEPTEMBER 2017

The data in this document sets out the junior allocation figures for the majority of Surrey's schools as of 18 April 2017. In some cases vacancies remained after the initial allocation to on time applicants and these were filled by applicants who had applied late. Where no measurement is shown, all applicants who applied on time were offered a place. In all other cases measurements relate to the last criterion for which places were offered. All distances quoted are in kilometres.
