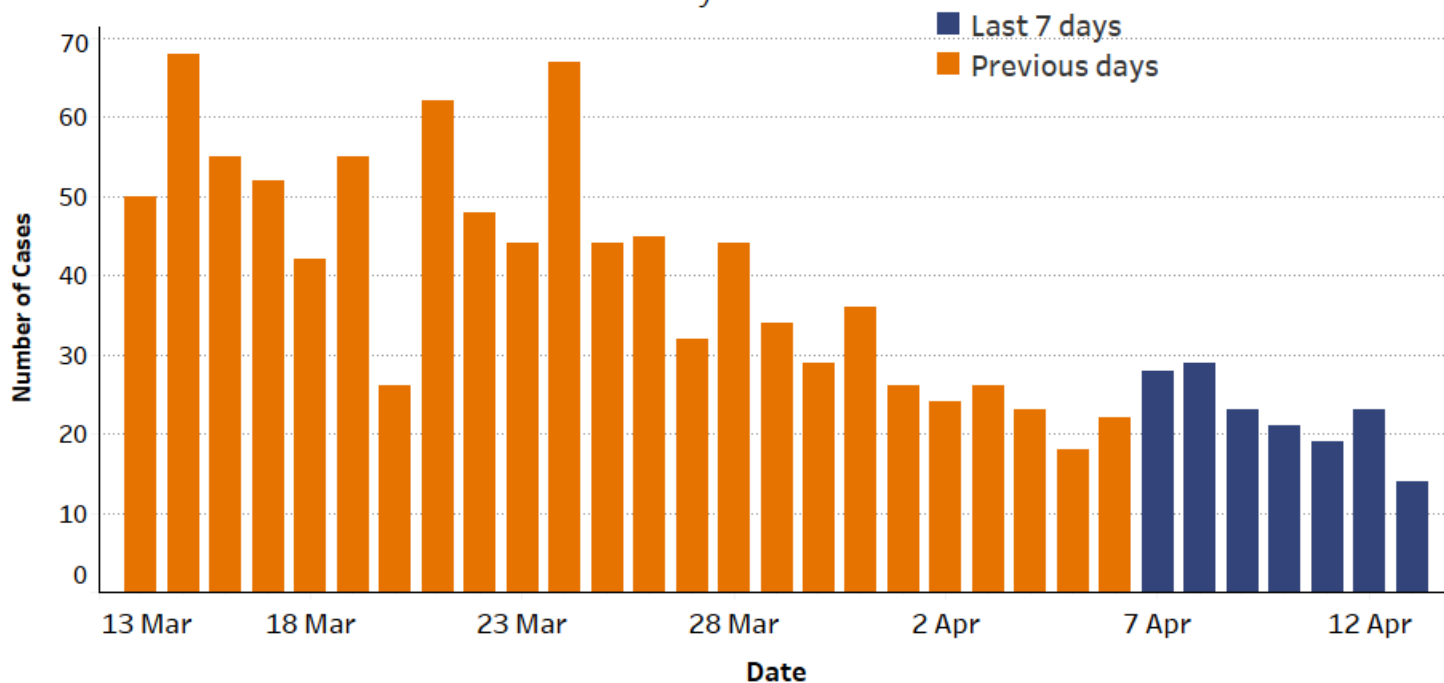

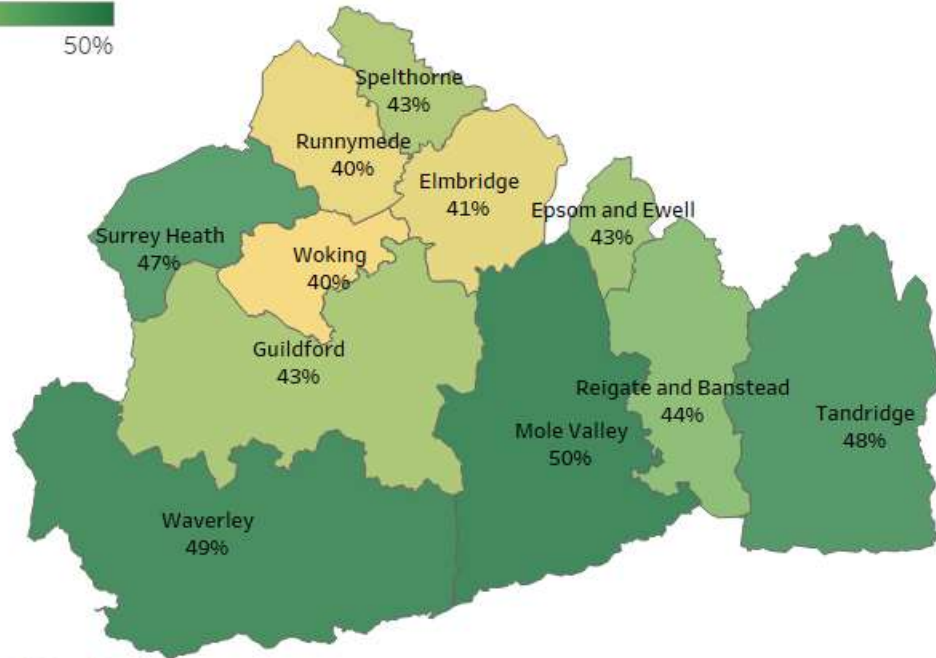

Data up to 11th April

Percentage of population who have had at least 1 dose of a vaccine

40% 50%



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6,310 people in Surrey have received their first dose of a COVID-19 vaccination this week (5th March to 11th April).

In total **574,079** people have received at least one dose of a vaccine (up to 11th April). This is **44%** of the population. **92%** of all people aged 60 or over in Surrey have received at least one dose of a vaccine

46% of all people in the South East have had at least 1 dose of a vaccine, and **44%** of people in England.

Groups currently eligible for a vaccine

- People aged 45 and over
- People who are clinically vulnerable and clinically extremely vulnerable
- People who live or work in care homes
- Health and social care workers
- People with a learning disability
- People who are a main carer for someone at high risk (clinically extremely vulnerable)

Vaccination figures are presented by date of vaccination as recorded on the National Immunisation Management Service (NIMS) database. Vaccination counts and populations by Lower Tier Local Authority (LTLA) are provided by Public Health England (PHE).
