Horsell Moor (D3639) Horsell
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 04 August 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Horsell Moor (D3639) Horsell as extends from its junction with (C140) Brewery Road to a point a point approximately 40 metres south eastwards along (D3639) Horsell Moor.

Alternative Route – Brewery Road; and Horsell Moor or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate electrical link box upgrade works to be carried out by, or on behalf of ALS Civil within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 4 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 10 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
