Steep Hill (D36) Chobham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 13 October 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of Steep Hill (D36) Chobham.

Alternative Routes –

- 1) Woodcock Lane; Windlesham Road; and Windsor Road or this same route in reverse;
- 2) Sparrow Road; Valley End Road; and Windsor Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate –

- (a) telecoms pole replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried between the hours of 8am and 6pm within 3 days commencing 19 October 2021; and
- (b) utility asset survey works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Zetica within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 6pm within 1 day commencing 22 October 2021.

Works are anticipated to be completed within 4 days of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order which commences on 19 October 2021. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

For part a) access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when it is required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.

For part b) access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for the emergency services, residents and businesses will be maintained via the signed diversion routes.
