Stoneleigh Road (D474) Limpsfield Chart
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 03 November 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Stoneleigh Road (D474) Limpsfield Chart as extends from a point in line with the western boundary of No.65 Stoneleigh Road to a point in line with the eastern boundary of No.69 Stoneleigh Road.

Alternative Route – Ridlands Rise; Tally Road; Moorhouse Road; and Stoneleigh Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UKPN within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8pm and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 15 November 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access residents, the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route.
