Various Roads in Spelthorne
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.3) 2021

On 10 November 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in

- (a) that length of Cecil Road (D6203) Ashford as extends from its junction with (A308) Staines Road West to its junction with (D6203) Service Road Fronting 341-373 Staines Road West; and
- (b) that length of Service Road Fronting 341-373 Staines Road West (D6203) Ashford as extends from its junction with (A308) Staines Road West north eastwards for a distance of approximately 15 metres.

Alternative Route – Cecil Road; Elgin Avenue; Feltham Hill Road; Chertsey Road; and A308 Staines Road West or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate sewerage cleaning works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Lanes Group PLC within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 10pm and 5.30am within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 21 November 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected lengths of road will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. Access for the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route.
