**The Surrey County Council**  
**Red Lane (C85) Limpsfield**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 24 November 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Red Lane (C85) Limpsfield as extends from its junction with (S10001) The Hollies northwards for approximately 50 metres.

Alternative Route –Pollards Wood Hill; Wolfs Road; A25 Westerham Road/East Hill/West Hill/Godstone Road; A22 Godstone By-Pass/Eastbourne Road; Ray Lane; Lingfield Common Road; Haxted Road; Dwelly Lane; and Red Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UKPN within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8pm and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 23 November 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. Access for the emergency services will be via the signed diversion route. Outside of working hours either a trench link or road plate will in place for access.
