Merle Common Road (C84) Merle Common
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 15 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Merle Common Road (C84) Merle Common that is crossed by the rail over road bridge identified as "HGG1/850" and for a distance of 20 metres either side.

Alternative Route - Merle Common Road; Red Lane; Pollards Oak Road; Hurstlands; Greenhurst Lane; Hurst Green Road; Holland Road; and Merle Common Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate railway bridge examination works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 10pm and 6am within the 18 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 27 December 2021. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route.
