Vicarage Road (B388) Egham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 22 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Vicarage Road (B388) Egham that is crossed by the level crossing and for 20m either side.

Alternative Route - Vicarage Road; High Street; Church Road; Station Road; Manorcrofts Road; Stroude Road; New Wickham Lane; and Vicarage Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate signal and telecom barrier maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice.

These works are anticipated to be carried out in three phases within the 18 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 04 January 2022.

Phase 1 - 2 nights between the hours of 11.30pm and 5am commencing 04 January 2022;
Phase 2 - 1 night between the hours of 11pm and 5.30am commencing 20 January 2022;
and Phase 3 - 1 night between the hours of 11.30pm and 5.30am commencing 06 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the Emergency Services will be maintained at all times. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be provided by Marshalls if required. All other traffic will be required to follow the diversion routes listed above.
