Dean Lane (C219) Merstham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 22 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Dean Lane (C219) Merstham as extends from its junction with the access to the property known as "Alderstead Heath Caravan and Motorhome Club" to its junction with (B2031) Alderstead Lane/Dean Lane.

Alternative Route – Alderstead Lane; Shepherds Hill; A23 London Road North; and Dean Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate access to overhead cabling for fibre connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 19 January 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
