Tilehurst Lane (D305) Dorking
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 19 January 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Tilehurst Lane (D305) Dorking that is crossed by the rail over road bridge No. 328 and for a distance of 50 metres either side.

Alternative Route – Park Pale Lane; Roothill Lane; Red Lane; Blackbrook Road; Chart Lane South; and Punchbowl Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate bridge repair and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 10pm and 6am within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 21 January 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the residents within the closure area and the Emergency Services will be maintained at all times. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be provided by Marshalls if required. All other traffic will be required to follow the diversion routes listed above.
