Sample Oak Lane (D216) Chilworth
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 26 January 2022 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) AND 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Sample Oak Lane (D216) Chilworth at its junction with (X7273) Blackheath and for a distance of 20 metres to either side.
- Alternative Route – Sample Oak Lane; Blackheath Lane; Wonersh Common; A248 Dorking Road / New Road; and Sample Oak Lane or this same route in reverse. and
- (b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council Sample Oak Lane (D216) Chilworth Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021” in so far as it affects that length of road described in part (a).

The Order is required to allow new mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Morrison Utility Services within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days within the 12 month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 07 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for residents will be maintained if safe to do so, otherwise access will be via the diversion route and for properties along (X7273) Blackheath will be via (D211) Blackheath Lane. The emergency services and all other traffic will be required to follow the signed diversion route.
