Notice Surrey County Council Goose Rye Road (D3680) Worplesdon Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 26 January 2022 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Goose Rye Road (D3680) Worplesdon which extends from its junction with Burdenshott Road to its junction with Upper Jordan Gooserye. This Order is required to enable BT to carry out tree cutting and overhead cabling works, which are anticipated to be completed between 8am and 6pm, during the 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 31 January 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. **Alternative Route** – Burdenshott Road, Smarts Heath Lane, Smarts Heath Road, Berry Lane, Bagshot Road, Rickford and Goose Rye Road.
