Cobham Road (D2508) Fetcham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 23 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Cobham Road (D2508) Fetcham as extends from its junction with (D2566) River Lane southwards for a distance of approximately 100 metres.

Alternative Routes:

- (1) Northbound – Cobham Road; Guildford Road; Waterway Road; A245 Station Road/Station Approach Road/Randalls Road/Woodlands Road; and Cobham Road;
- (2) Southbound – Cobham Road; A245 Woodlands Lane/Woodlands Road/Randalls Road/Bull Hill/Station Road; Waterway Road; Guildford Road; and Cobham Road.

The Order is required to facilitate railway bridge examination works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 9pm and 5am within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 22 June 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access pedestrians, and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for the residents and the emergency services will be via the diversion route.
