Gardeners Hill Road (D115) Wrecclesham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 16 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Gardeners Hill Road (D115) Wrecclesham as extends from its junction with Frensham Court north-westwards for a distance of approximately 160 metres.

Alternative Route – Gardeners Hill Road; Longdown Road; Burnt Hill Road; A287 Frensham Road; Frensham Vale; and Gardeners Hill Road or this same route in reverse; and

- (b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council Gardeners Hill Road (D115) Wrecclesham Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021” in so far as it affects that length of road described in part (a).

The Order is required to allow telecoms pole replacement and/or cabling and/or utility maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 8am and 4pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 23 March 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
