Sandy Lane (D6851) Cobham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 30 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Sandy Lane (D6851) Cobham as extends from its junction with (X1711) Hill Close to its junction with (D6851) Brackenhill.

Alternative Route – Sandy Lane; A244 Warren Lane/High Street/Leatherhead Road/Oxshott Road; Oaklawn Road; A245 Woodlands Road/Woodlands Lane/Stoke Road; Fairmile Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow new telecoms fibre connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 04 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
