Dogflud Way (B3228) Farnham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 13 April 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Dogflud Way (B3228) Farnham (formerly known as the A325 Dogflud way and/or A325 East Street Loop Road) as extends from its southwestern junction with (B3228) East Street to its junction with (D5337) Mike Hawthorn Drive and
- (b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council (A325 East Street and East Street Loop Road) Farnham (One way working) Order 1980” in so far as it affects (B3228) Dogflud Way.

The alternative route will be via East Street; Guildford Road; Shepherd and Flock Roundabout; A31 Farnham By-Pass; Coxbridge Roundabout; West Street; The Borough; Bear Lane; Woolmead; and East Street.

The Order is required to allow carriageway resurfacing and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of FM Conway within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 nights between the hours of 10pm and 6am within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 20 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure and suspension will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the emergency services and pedestrians will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access for residents, businesses and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion routes.

The Council are satisfied that, in accordance with Section 3(2)(a) and 3(2)(b) of the Act, vehicular access to and from premises within the length of road above or accessible only therefrom may be restricted in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and/or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
