**The Wickets (D6338) Ashford**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 20 April 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of The Wickets (D6338) Ashford at its junction with (C240) Woodthorpe Road.

There is no applicable alternative route.

The Order is required to facilitate Esso pipeline installation works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Eurovia Contracting South along (C240) Woodthorpe Road. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 4 weeks between the hours of 9am and 5pm Monday to Saturday within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 25 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closures will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the emergency services, pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times as will pedestrian access to properties within the closure area. During the working hours, vehicular access to premises in The Wickets will be restricted, when this is the case such restriction of access will apply for no more than eight hours within any 24-hour period and road plates will be in situ outside of these times to allow vehicular access to The Wickets
