Portsmouth Road (A3100) Godalming
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 04 May 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Portsmouth Road (A3100) Godalming as extends from its junction at the roundabout with (A3100) Ockford Road and (D5404) Shackstead Lane to its junction at the roundabout with (A286) Church Road and (C32) Station Lane.

Alternative Route - A3100 Portsmouth Road; A283 Guildford Road; A3 Guildford-Godalming By-Pass; A25 Midleton Road; A322 Woodbridge Road/Onslow Street; A3100 Park Street/Portsmouth Road/Old Portsmouth Road/Guildford Road/Meadrow/Bridge Road; and A3100 Flambard Way/Ockford Road.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms pole replacement and/or new pole installation and/or cabling and/or utility maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 15 May 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
