The Surrey County Council
Chobham Road (C11) and Swallow Rise (D3784), Knaphill
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 18 May 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of

- (a) Chobham Road (C11) Knaphill from its junction with the access to the properties known as "Meadow End" and "The Priory Hospital" to its junction with (D3784) Larks Way.

Alternative Route – Chobham Road; Barrs Lane; Littlewick Lane; Anchor Hill; High Street; and Chobham Road or this same route in reverse; and

- (b) Swallow Rise (D3784) Knaphill at its junction with (C11) Chobham Road.

Alternative Route – Swallow Rise; and Larks Way or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Affinity Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 23 May 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for residents, pedestrians, and cyclists within the closure area will be maintained at all times, access for the emergency services will be via the signed diversion routes.
