**Battlebridge Lane (C225) Merstham**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 25 May 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Battlebridge Lane (C225) Merstham that is crossed by the rail over road bridge identified as “VTB2 97” and for a distance of 20 metres either side.

Alternative Route – Battlebridge Lane; New Battlebridge Lane; A23 London Road South/London Road/Princess Way; A25 Redstone Hill/Nutfield Road/High Street/Bletchingley Road/Castle Street; Little Common Lane; Pendell Road; Bletchingley Road; Nutfield Road; and Battlebridge Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate detailed bridge inspection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 11.30pm and 6am within the 18-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 07 June 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will operate only when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for residents, the emergency services, pedestrians, and dismantled cyclists will be maintained when safe to do so by operatives on site.
