A323 Guildford Road, Ash
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 30 November 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of A323 Guildford Road, Ash that is comprised within the level-crossing and for a distance of 20 metres either side.

This Traffic Order is required to enable Network Rail to carry out barrier replacement and/or maintenance works at the level crossing. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 9pm and 6am, within 4 nights of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 05 December 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

No sole access to any property will be affected. Access for emergency services, pedestrians and, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. The vehicular diversion route will be via Guildford Road, Aldershot Road, Worplesdon Road, A3 Guildford-Godalming By-Pass, Farnham Road, Hogs Back, Blackwater Valley Road, Aldershot Road, Ash Street, Ash Church Road, and Guildford Road.
