Temporary Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading in Riversdale Road (D6956) and Ashley Road (D6957) Thames Ditton and Temporary Prohibition of Traffic in Church Walk (T5000) Thames Ditton 2023

On 01 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the following Temporary Orders pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act"): -

(1) "The Surrey County Council Riversdale Road (D6956) and Ashley Road (D6957) Thames Ditton Temporary Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading Order 2023" under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of The Act, the effect of which will be to

(a) prohibit waiting, loading and unloading at any time by vehicles on both sides of the carriageway in

(i) the entire length of Riversdale Road (D6956) Thames Ditton

(ii) that length of Ashley Road (D6957) Thames Ditton as extends from its junction with (X6957) Harvest Lane to its junction with (D6957) Church Lane

(iii) that length of Ashley Road (D6957) Thames Ditton as extends from its junction with Church Walk (Townpath) (T5000) Thames Ditton to a point in line with the eastern boundary line of No.22 Ashley Road

(b) Suspend

(i) "The Surrey County Council (Various Roads In Elmbridge) (Revocation And Consolidation Of Waiting, Loading And Unloading Prohibition And Restriction) Order 2021" as amended insofar as it relates to that length of road specified in parts (1)(a)(i) and (1)(a)(ii)

(ii) "The Surrey County Council Ashley Road (D6957) Thames Ditton Temporary Prohibition of Waiting Loading and Unloading Order 2022" in its entirety

(2) "The Surrey County Council Church Walk (T5000) Thames Ditton Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023, under Section 14(1) of The Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from entering or proceeding on foot or by any other means in the entire length of Church Walk (T5000) Thames Ditton. Alternative routes – (1) Ashley Road and Church Lane. (2) Speer Road, Station Road, High Street and Ashley Road, (3) Church Land, Ashley Road, and High Street.

The Order in part (1) which will commence on 20 February 2023 for a period of 12 months and the Order in part (2) which will commence on 25 July 2023 for a period of 6 months are required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of SGN, including but not limited to: gas mains replacement works. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, waiting restrictions and suspensions, which are anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed

The works in part (1)(a)(i) are anticipated to commence on 20 February 2023 for a period of 7 weeks, between the hours of 8am and 4pm. The works in parts (1)(a)(ii), (1)(a)(iii) and part (2) are anticipated to commence on 25 July 2023 for a period of 7 weeks between the hours of 8am and 4pm.

Access for residents, the emergency services, pedestrians, and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. All other traffic will be required to use the signed diversion routes.
