D367 Effingham Lane, Copthorne
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 01 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to: - 1. Prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of D367 Effingham Lane, Copthorne that extends from the north-western property boundary of "The Driftway", northwards for 50m, and from the south-western property boundary of "The Driftway", southwards for 50m. 2. Suspend "The Surrey County Council Various Roads in Copthorne and Godstone Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022" insofar as affects the length of D367 Effingham Lane, Copthorne described in part 1. to this Notice. This Traffic Order is required to enable UK Power Networks to carry out excavations and/or connection and/or maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 5pm, within 5 days of the 6 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 13 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents, businesses, pedestrians and, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times via the alternative route: - Effingham Lane, Effingham Road, West Park Road, Mill Lane and Effingham Lane.
