

How to Vote in Person







You can bring your polling card to the polling station. There will be signs to show you where to go. The polling station staff will ask you your address. This is to make sure you are on their list to vote.



They will ask you to show your photo ID.

The staff will give you your ballot paper(s). This is what you use to make your vote.




You can ask the polling station staff for help or to show you what to do. They must make reasonable adjustments for you.



Take your ballot paper to one of the polling booths. This is a private area where you can vote.

Your Vote

Use the pencil to put a cross next to who you want to vote for. Don't put any other marks on the ballot paper.



Fold the paper in half. Walk over to the ballot box and post it in. This is a locked box where all votes are kept safe.

Don't talk about who you voted for in the polling station, wait until you are away from it.
