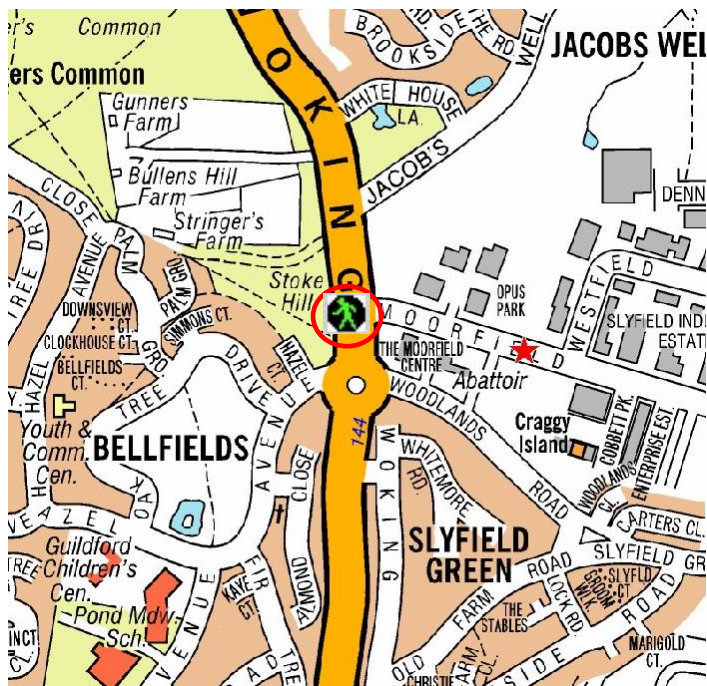

We will be replacing and improving the traffic lights and pedestrian crossing on the A320 Woking Road, Jacob Wells at the junction with Moorfield Road.

We will be replacing all the traffic light equipment as it has become obsolete and is in poor condition.

The location of the work is highlighted on the map on this leaflet.

There will be lane restrictions to carry out these works.

Temporary signals will operate for 24 hours a day.
