

NOTICE

The Surrey County Council Oakshade Road (D6862) Oxshott Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2020

On 22 December 2020 Surrey County Council ("The Council") Made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act"), the effect of which will be temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of Oakshade Road (D6862) Oxshott. The alternative route for all vehicles will be via (D6861) Steels Lane; and (A244) High Street or this same route in reverse.

This order is required to enable coring works and/or carriageway repair works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Surrey County Council. These works are anticipated to be carried out within 4 weeks during the 18 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 06 January 2021 and continues in force the provisions introduced by "Surrey County Council Oakshade Road (D6862) Oxshott Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Notice 2020" issued under S14(2) of the Act on 17 December 2020. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for the emergency services, pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times, due to the nature of the works there will be no vehicular access for residents within the closure area. Residents and all other vehicular traffic will be required to follow the diversion route listed above.

The Council are satisfied that, in accordance with Section 3(2)(a) and 3(2)(b) of The Act, vehicular access to and from premises within the length of road above, or accessible only therefrom may be restricted in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and/or preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising
