Foxholes (D3892) Weybridge
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 07 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Foxholes (D3892) Weybridge as extends from the northern kerb line of its junction with (D3892) Fox Close to a point approximately 60 meters northwards along the westernmost arm of (D3892) Foxholes. The alternative route will be via the easternmost arm of (D3892) Foxholes.

The Order is required to facilitate electrical works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UK Power Networks within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 18 July 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents within the closure area, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the diversion route given above.
