Frimley Road (B3411) Frimley
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 20 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of the north-westbound carriageway of Frimley Road (B3411) Frimley that is crossed by the M3 Overbridge and for a distance of 45 meters on either side.
- (b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council Frimley Road (B3411) Frimley (Bus and Cycle Lane) Order 2021” insofar as it relates to that length of road described in part (a) to this Notice.

Alternative Route – A325 Frimley By-Pass / Farnborough Road; Bradfords Roundabout; A331 Blackwater Valley Road (Northbound); The Meadows Roundabout; A30 London Road; and Frimley Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate carriageway fencing panel work to be carried out by, or on behalf of Highways England within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 7 weeks between the hours of 9pm and 5.30am within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences 01 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents and businesses within the closure, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for the emergency services will be via the signed diversion route.
