**The Surrey County Council**  
**Barton Road (D210) Bramley**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 18 August 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Barton Road (D210) Bramley as extends from its junction with (D210) Barton Road in the vicinity of the property known as “Lamorna” to a point approximately 75 metres north westwards along (D210) Barton Road.

There is no applicable diversion route, however road plates will be on site.

The Order is required to facilitate new mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Morrison Utility Services within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 30 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times via roadplates, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
