Lower Guildford Road (D3605) Knaphill
Temporary One-Way Traffic Order 2021

On 18 August 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Lower Guildford Road (D3605) Knaphill as extends from its junction with (D3607) Victoria Road to a point in line with the south western boundary of No.22 Lower Guildford Road in any direction other than south-eastwards.

Alternative Route – A324 Hermitage Road / Amstel Way; Lockfield Drive; Littlewick Road; Anchor Hill; Lower Guildford Road.

The Order is required to facilitate mains water repair and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Affinity Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 8.30am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 24 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary one-way system, which is anticipated to be required 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. The above restrictions shall not apply to vehicles being used in relation to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the road by or on behalf of the Police. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists. Access for all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route.
