Woodland Grove (D3871) Weybridge
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.2) 2021

On 20 October 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:

- (a) to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Woodland Grove (D3871) Weybridge as extends from a point in line with the north western boundary of No. 43 Woodland Grove to a point in line with the south eastern boundary of No. 49 Woodland Grove; and
- (b) suspend "The Surrey County Council Woodland Grove (D3871) Weybridge Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021" in its entirety.

The alternative route will be via southern and western arms of Woodland Grove.

The Order is required to facilitate new mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Shift Traffic Management within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm in within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 25 October 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians, and dismounted cyclists. Access for emergency vehicles and all other traffic will be maintained via the signed diversion route.
