Clarks Lane (B2024) Tatsfield
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 15 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Clarks Lane (B2024) Tatsfield as extends from its junction with (D488) Chestnut Avenue and (D477) Church Hill to its junction with (C80) Rectory Lane.

Alternative Route - Clarks Lane; Croydon Road; A25 High Street/Westerham Road; High Street; Titsey Road; and Titsey Hill or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate access to the overhead telecoms network to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 31 December 2021. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. All through traffic will be required to follow the signed diversion route.
