**The Surrey County Council**  
**Clandon Avenue (D3164) Egham**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 22 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Clandon Avenue (D3164) Egham as extends from its junction with (D3164) Warwick Avenue north westwards for a distance of approximately 60 metres.

Alternative Route – Warwick Avenue; Ashleigh Avenue; and Clandon Avenue or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate new sewerage connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of NG Tunnelling within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 weeks between the hours of 8.30am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday, and 8.30pm and 1.30pm on Saturdays within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 10 January 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
