Fordbridge Road (B377) Ashford
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 22 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit any person from entering or proceeding on foot or by any other means in that length of footway adjacent to the northwest bound lane of Fordbridge Road (B377) Ashford as extends from its junction with (X67407) Badgers Close to its junction with (D3249) Gables Avenue.

There is no applicable alternative route and pedestrians and cyclists will be required to use the footway on the opposite side of the carriageway.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms utility works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 12 January 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
